Guideline for claim of Generation Based Incentive (GBI)

1. Objectives:-

- i) broaden investor base
- ii) Incentivize Power Generation from the efficient Solar PV Plants installed by the Domestic Consumers in the state of Delhi.

2. <u>Incentive and Duration</u>:-

Generation Based Incentive (GBI) of INR 2.00 per unit (kWh) of Gross Solar Energy generated is being offered for a period of 3 years starting from 01.01.2016 till 31.12.2018 on first come first serve basis. The minimum eligibility criteria for availing the benefit of GBI will be:

- i) The solar plant should have generated minimum of 1,100 units (kWh) per annum per kWp. Those solar plants that generate less than 1,100 units (kWh) per kWp in a year shall not be eligible to avail GBI facility.
- ii) The annual solar energy generation that is eligible for GBI has been capped at 1,500 kWh per kWp, irrespective of the readings of the solar generation meter.

3. <u>Eligibility</u>:-

The GBI is available for existing and future Solar Plants installed at the rooftops of domestic consumers. The eligibility for payment of GBI to consumers who have already installed Net-Meter shall be effective from the date of notification of Delhi Solar Policy-2016 i.e. 27.09.2016.

4. Exercise to be done for claim of GBI:-

Consumers who are willing to avail Generation Based Incentive (GBI) shall have to carry out following exercise:-

- Consumer should have a valid CA Number issued from the Distribution
 Company supplying power to him
- ii) Consumer to install a Solar PV System of capacity not less than 1 Kwp at his Rooftop

iii) Consumer to get a Net-meter installed from the Distribution Company under the jurisdiction of which his area falls.

5. Responsibility of Distribution Company:-

- i) Distribution Company will take the monthly reading of Solar Power Generated from Energy Meter installed at the premises consumer
- ii) Distribution Company will adjust the amount of GBI against electricity bills of the eligible consumer as is being done in case of electricity subsidy.
- iii) Distribution Company will claim the amount (along with proof of solar power generated and payment to consumers) from EE & REM Centre, annually.
- iv) The concerned Distribution Company will provide the list of consumers along with the solar energy generation details to EE&REM Centre.

6. Responsibility of EE & REM Centre:

- i) EE & REM Centre, after verification of the bills shall release the GBI payment to Distribution Companies
- ii) EE & REM Centre reserves the right to call data of any eligible consumer from Distribution Company to verify the record before release of payment towards GBI.
- iii) EE & REM Centre reserves the right to verify the data from the Solar Power Meter installed at the premises of the eligible consumer.
- iv) EE & REM Centre also reserves the right to stop payment of GBI to Distribution Company in case any discrepancy in the data/information provided is found to be incorrect by the Centre.
